- o Pay-per-sale This time, profits are shared every time a customer makes a purchase on the merchant's site through an affiliate link. In return, an affiliate might earn a commission based on a flat rate or a certain percentage of the product's price.
- o Pay-per-lead Every time someone registers on the merchant's site as a potential customer, affiliates earn a certain amount with this type of deal.

Marketing through affiliates benefits both parties. Merchants do not really have to do anything in this arrangement. This also saves money since they do not have to pay up if nothing is



happening. On the other hand, site owners could use their revenues to maintain their site. With enough effort, some may even work as full-time affiliate marketers.

Of course there are a few drawbacks as well. For instance, merchants have to be careful on which sites to market their product. Affiliates need to be trustworthy enough not to drag their partners with bad publicity. Commissions that are too small could also lead to bad business relationship between merchant and affiliate.



What Is Drop Shipping?

Once you have closed a deal and sold your product, your next task is to send it to your customer's way. Shipping always has an effect on your standing as an online seller which is why you need to do this right.

One option you have is drop shipping. This is a supply chain management method where the seller does not keep his products in stock. Instead, customer orders are handled by the wholesaler or the manufacturer.

In online businesses, a seller lists an item as new and ships it directly to the buyer from the wholesaler. Profit results from the difference between the retail and wholesale price. Alternatively, sellers may also earn based on a commission agreed upon with the wholesaler.

The slight delay between the order of an item and its shipment is not a bad thing in this set up. In fact, it is a good thing because customers do not expect to walk out with their purchase. This is why it is preferred by small businesses and online retailers.

Another thing that is good about is control over your inventory. In drop shipping, you do not keep a stock of the items you have for sale. In effect, there is no need for a storage area and employees to handle the items and secure them from theft. This means fewer expenses to spend on.

Of course there are manufacturers who would refuse to drop ship their products. They might require someone to oversee



shipment and processing orders. Some only accept bulk shipping which may not be an option for your business.

The problems outweigh the benefits though. As an online entrepreneur, you will have more time to spend on other business matters.





What Is Web Hosting?

For online business to work, you need your own website set up. One important thing you should not forget is web hosting. This is a service which allots space for your site on computer servers which are connected to the internet. Space is rented for anyone who wants online presence.

Web hosting comes in a variety of types each with its own capabilities. Scripts for interactive functions, bulletin boards and forms among others may be included. Web hosting for businesses is made possible through commercial packages that include features such as credit card processing.

In simple terms, an autoresponder is programmed to generate a response every time it receives information. Email management was its first use but it has now expanded to websites. As such, it can be a powerful and versatile tool for online businesses.

Instant responses may be sent to customers thanking them for their purchase. The same can be done when receiving payments having their item shipped out. This effectively automates the customer service experience. Additionally, it almost guarantees customer satisfaction since customers always get a response from you.

Autoresponders may also be programmed to send out newsletters and catalogues of your latest offerings. This means you can keep your customers in the loop and encourage future purchases. You should know that existing customers are more likely to buy again.

There are plenty of autoresponder service providers out there. Each one has a different set of features that works well with specific types of businesses. You want to do as much research on these as possible before signing up for an account.

One feature you might want to consider is personalization. This lets you put your customer's name in the message. This



seemingly small feature can in fact drive up your sales. Even in the modern world, people will still appreciate something that was mad especially for them.

What Is A Sales Letter?

Sometimes, simply waiting for potential customers to end up in your website and make a purchase is not enough. For very specific market niches you might need to implement a more targeted approach and this is done through the use of sales letter.

For example, if you wish to target old people that are over their 60s, waiting for them to view your pages might not be a very good idea. Mostly, old folks are not into browsing the web. To make a more pinpointed approach, you might want to send them sales letters instead.

But the trick is not just run-of-the-mill writing of letters and presenting what you have to offer. In this day and age of aggressive online marketing, most people are already too fed up with sales letters. As soon as they see it, they delete it or ignore it without even reading it.

So when making a sales letter, you have to employ every strategy necessary to make sure that your addressee will read your message and make that purchase.

As one of the most prominent and most successful online marketing expert who specializes in sales letters, Bill Myers suggests that those who wish to make an effective sales letter must give emphasis on the following:

- Headline
- Captions
- Visuals, images, photos



- The PS message
- Order Slip
- Body

According to him, people look at parts of the sales letters in this order. So if for example the headline sounds too crappy or contains too many 'sales' clichés, the addressee might be put off.

Myers also suggests to highlight or bold important lines such as lose weight naturally without side effects and money-back guarantee in order to give emphasis to key points. Another trick is using single sentence paragraphs to emphasize.

The real problem with this method is acquiring contacts to send your letters to. These contacts are called leads. You either acquire them on your own or you buy them from reputable lead sources online.



What Is A Squeeze Page/Opt-In Page?

Discussed previously is the email marketing strategy. So the question now is where do you get email addresses to make up your contact list? There are many ways but one widely used effective method is the employment of a squeeze page.

To put it simply, a squeeze page is a simplified html or web page that prompts a reader or potential customer to provide their name and email address, sometimes only the latter. A number of strategies are used in order to convince the reader that providing his/her email address will be worth the while.

For example, some webmasters will offer freebies to those who will sign up. This is where electronic products such as eBooks can come in handy. You can keep giving the same eBook to every reader as long as you own the copyright to the eBook, have rights to distribute it as such, or the eBook comes with a unlimited re-distribution policy.

For marketers that are looking for subscribers, they may offer the reader a month of free trial. Some may also give away coupons. The list can be endless.

When making a squeeze page, it is advisable to keep things simple. The text must be an easy read and important words and phrases must be given emphasis. Graphics design is also important to attract the reader. If your offer is good, your reader will provide you his/her contact information. That will become part of your contact list. You will be able to send updates, product offers, and other promos in the future to these contacts.



How Do I Know What People Are Searching For?

When it comes to internet marketing, keywords are everything. They will be one of your greatest weapons that will determine whether you win the market or not. If you use the right ones, internet users will find you with ease. If you use the wrong ones, you will be invisible on the net. How is this so?

When people go to search engine sites such as Google and Yahoo in order to find something, they use a keyword or a keyword phrase. Say for example a teenager wants to find an acne solution, he/she may use any of the following: acne treatment, acne solution, how to treat acne, acne for teenagers, and et cetera.

So what you really want to know are the exact keywords and keyword phrases that your target customers or the people in your market niche are using. If you do this, it is highly likely that they will always end up in your web pages. So how do you do it?

One way is to enter your main keyword on the search engine of Google and wait for the search bar to make phrase suggestions. For example, once you enter the word acne solution, other suggestions such as Acne Solutions Clinique, Acne Solutions That Work, and Acne Solutions Gel Lotion will appear in the drop down list.

It means that these keyword phrases are popularly used by internet users. You will do well to incorporate these keyword phrases to your web content along with your main keyword.



A more effective solution however is the use of Google keyword tool called Adwords. You simply enter your main keyword and Google will show you related keyword phrases and how often people are using those keywords.

In the example of the main keyword acne solution, Google Adword yielded the following top results:

- How to get rid of acne 550,000 monthly searches
- Acne remedy 201,000 monthly searches
- Remedies for acne 246,000 monthly searches
- Cures for acne 110,000 monthly searches



What is SEO?

SEO stands for Search Optimization Engine. Simply put, it is an online marketing technique that is focused on making sure that your web site or web pages will always appear among the top search list when people search the web for keywords related to your market niche. So when someone goes looking for acne solutions, your web site will have good chances of appearing as one of the top 10 or even the top 5 results if your website is enhanced with SEO.

So how do web masters make sure that their web pages are SEO enhanced? There are many techniques. One is Article Writing. Using this technique, the owner of the web page fills his website with well-written articles that are stuffed with keywords and keyword phrases related to his/her market niche. Posting new articles may be necessary from time to time.

Another technique is called Backlinking. To define, backlinks are hyperlinks appearing on other web pages and other web sites that direct people to your own web page. So if there is a hyperlink in Website A that connects readers to Website B, you can say that the hyperlink in Website A is a backlink to Website B. Simply put, a website will have higher chances of making it to the top of the search engine results list if it has plenty of backlinks.

Other parts of the web page where web masters place keywords and keyword phrases include the following: the domain name, the headings, the title, site text, and others.



But why is it important to stuff your webpage with keywords and backlinks in order for it to be SEO enhanced? This is because when Google searches for web sites related to the keyword provided by the user, it sends out little spiders to crawl out every nook and cranny of the web. And what these spiders are looking for are keywords and backlinks.





What Is Traffic?

You can imagine that cables, wires, and on-air signals where electronic data travels via the internet can be likened to highways with busy motorists going from all directions. And just like in roads, these mediums for electronic data also experience traffic. Thus, internet traffic is a condition wherein one line is getting too many signals because a lot of people are requesting to view its pages.

This goes to say that if a website has poor traffic it is not getting enough views. Likewise, if a website has lots of traffic it means people are always viewing it. For internet marketers, getting a lot of traffic into their website is a necessity. This is because more views mean more opportunities to make a sale.

However, you have to take note that certain lines and web hosting can only handle enough traffic. Some cannot handle too much while some can handle a lot. So if you are into online marketing and you are aiming to get a lot of traffic, you have to be sure that your web hosting can accommodate heavy internet traffic.



What Are Some Traffic Methods?

As already discussed, generating traffic is very important to online marketers. It is the life and blood of their marketing strategies. So if you want to succeed in this line of business, you need to know how to increase traffic into your website. How do you do this?

There are many methods. One of them is the use of SEO. By enhancing the SEO characteristics of a website, there is a higher chance that it will appear on top search results of search engines such as Google and thus securing higher visitation rates.

Other methods include the use of Advertisements posted on major sites such as Facebook, Google, and Yahoo. Because these sites are always visited by internet users, it is an advantage to secure an advertisement on their pages. What you really want is for the users to see your banner. Other methods include the use pop-up ads, newsletters, sales letters, and such.

If you are good at doing SEO on your own, then you can generate traffics without having to pay. But if you want to delegate this task to professionals in the field, there are people you can hire online. They are experts in optimizing a site for increased traffic.

And lastly, there are traffic generation programs which you can buy online. These applications work differently so you might want to choose a product that is easier for you to control. Usually, all you need to do is input your target market niche (target customer) and the program will do the rest for you.



What Is List Building?

In internet marketing, you only want to focus your advertisement on your target niche. This will save you time, energy, and advertisement related costs. For example, if you want to target teenagers, there is no more need to invest too much on reaching the elderly users. So how is this related to list building?

List building is the act of collecting contacts for you to send newsletters, sales letters, offers, and such. Of course, there are multiple ways for you to collect emails of your targeted customers. One popular method is the use of a squeeze page.

Simply put, a squeeze page is web page, usually simplified, which prompts readers to provide their email address and sometimes their names as well. Since readers would usually think twice about providing such information, internet marketers usually make free offers to encourage the readers to leave their contact information.

For example, a squeeze page can tell the reader that he/she can avail of a free eBook in return for leaving his/her email address. For subscription sites, they may offer free membership trial for a short period of time.

Another way to build a list is by purchasing them from online sellers of leads. The problem however is that there is usually no telling how these sellers acquired the list which they are selling. Some of the leads they may provide might be unreliable or recycled.



Another method usually used by online marketers is the use of article marketing. This works in a pretty similar way as SEO articles. So what you do is you come up with well-written and interesting articles that talk about your product or your services. This is meant to entice the interest of the reader. Once readers are interested, they will seek out your webpage. This will make it a lot easier to convince them to provide their email address once they are lead to the squeeze page.



What Is Blogging?

Simply think of social media sites such as Facebook and Twitter and you will already get an idea of what blogging is. So generally speaking, a blog is a webpage which shells out information in chronological order. Also, it is understood that a blog is supposed to provide updates continuously and regularly.

As you can already imagine, blog sites are initially used as personal online diaries. Later on however, they became useful to online marketers as well. They provided a means for online merchants to regularly provide updates about their products, services, offers, and such. It became a very powerful advertisement and promotional tool for them.

Also, online marketers can easily keep archives of articles and different topics with the use of a blog site. So generally, it helps customers and prospect customers find the information they need about the company, the product, and/or the services offered.

This also gives online marketers the opportunity to easily create backlinks to their main webpage. So if the main website is www.shoesforsale.com for example, the owner of the site can establish a separate blog site which will contain plenty of hyperlinks that will direct readers to www.shoesforsale.com.

Another important aspect of blogging which online marketers take advantage of is the use of comments. Although a blog may not accept comments from readers, many blogs actually do.



This way, online marketers can get plenty of feedback from customers and readers.

This will be very important in determining what the target niche wants, what they are not satisfied about, what they are happy about, and some other concerns. Simply put, blogging is a very important marketing tool to online merchants.





What Is Article Marketing?

As one of the most effective marketing tools used by online marketers, you would do well to know what article marketing is and how it is done. Simply put, article marketing is the strategy of making well-written articles that talk about your products, your company, or anything about your targeted market niche and disseminate them throughout the web.

For example, if an online shop that sells futon covers want to generate traffic through the use of article marketing, it will want to publish articles with titles like "10 Tips When Buying Futon Covers", "Popular Styles And Designs For Futon Covers This Fall", and "How To Match Futon Covers With The Interior Design".

As you can see, these titles are not directly promoting any brand or any company. Instead, such titles create credibility and



good image for the brand and/or company that wrote the articles.

And because Article Marketing is generally meant to generate traffic, they are often incorporated with SEO techniques, that is to say, they are written to include popular keywords and keyword phrases related to the targeted market niche.

Generally, a density of around 2 to 3 percent is standard. Any more than that might black list the article as 'spam'. Also, the typical length of articles would be around 300 to 500 words. This is short enough so that it is not boring, but long enough so that it is informative.

What Is Copywriting?

Do not let the word 'copy' fool you into thinking that this is all about making copies of already existing write ups or articles. Instead, copywriting is a marketing strategy which makes use of the power of words to persuade and encourage readers to become buyers. It also entices customers to return and purchase again.

So basically, what a copywriter does is come up with catch phrases and lines which are so powerful that they can convince people. If you are a seller of online products for example and you need a description for your products on display, you might want to get a copywriter.



Instead of just listing the specifications list, what the product is about, what the service includes, or what offers are included in the package, a copywriter skillfully crafts words so that boring information are outlaid beautifully so that they are convincing and catchy.

This is different from Article Marketing in a sense that it directly promotes a product, service, and/or company. At times, it may even be used to promote a person and build that person's reputation.

What Is Social Media And How Can I Leverage On It?

It is hard to imagine anyone who is adept with the use of the internet to not know about social media sites. These are very rampant nowadays and a lot of people spend most of their online time on such sites. Good and popular examples include Facebook, Twitter, and perhaps the old Friendster.

They can be used to reach specific target niches. For advertisement example, Facebook allows targeted advertisement to users based on age, region, gender, and groups joined.

products, services, offers, and such. Twitter for example is a very popular tool for companies to post regular updates.

Another beauty of this marketing strategy is how you can reach more than just firsthand customers. So if you managed to reach one person for example, you might also have access to that person's friends, family, and colleagues. In Facebook for example, this is best represented by the 'Share' function.

Social media sites can also be used to create backlinks and post articles. As such, online marketers can maximize use of social media sites to generate more traffic into their main website. This can also be used for list building.

And because social media sites almost always allow readers and users to post comments, it will allow companies to gather useful feedbacks from customers and prospect customers. So to sum it up, the benefits are plentiful. If you want to succeed in online marketing, you would do well to exploit social media sites. They are currently the fad in the World Wide Web.
