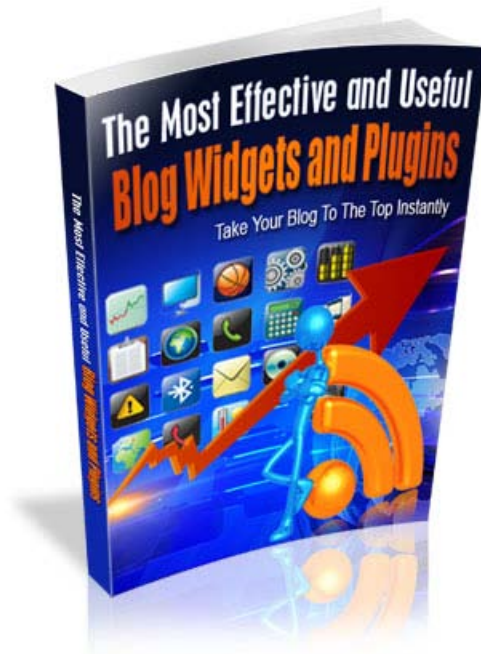

These days blogs seem to make the internet go round. In fact, the numbers are staggering- 50 million and growing every day. Bloggers come in all shapes and sizes and from all walks of life. Whether you are keeping your clients abreast of the current real estate market or you are blogging about your pet, there are all kinds of effective and useful blog widgets and plugins that can make your blog more exciting and appealing.

Widgets are a simple, effective, and handy way to add a little flare and excitement to your blog. Since the number of widgets and plugins available is virtually endless make sure you don't go overboard.

Popular Blog Sites

Before we start looking at the various widgets and plugins you can use on your blog, let's look at some of the most popular blog hosts. Everyone knows about WordPress, the number one used blog site, but there are plenty of other options you should be aware of so let's get started.

Danga Software Powered

Danga Interactic was the brainchild of Brad Fitzpatrick's company that created Live Journal and the backend to drive that software. There have been a number of contributors to this software since its early inception. The following are three of the main sites that are Danga powered.

1. InsaneJournal.com

InsaneJournal offers both free and paid accounts, with additional enhancements. It is a simple online diary that is very customizable, built on open source software. InsaneJournal lets you keep in touch with friends and family. Don't let the fact that it's free fool you. This is an excellent tool and the community is very tight-knit and accepting of everyone young or old.

2. JournalFen.com

JournalFen is directed towards "fandoms" such as various TV shows or movies like Harry Potter. It is designed for those over 18 years of age and is considered a journaling service for fans of television, movie, and music, as well as other media entertainment forms.

3. LiveJournal.com

Live Journal is one of the most well known and well used blog hosts offering its users multiple account types including paid and ad supported. This vibrant virtual global community is a social media platform where passions can be shared. There are hundreds of communities. You can keep a journal, diary, or blog.

Themed Blog Sites

- **Blogabond.com** – This is a blog site dedicated to travel blogs and it includes map integration. Here you'll discover tons of travel journals and photo blogs from individual travelers of the world. There is also maps, research, and plenty of resources if you are planning some backpacking.
- **BlogCheese.com** – A video blogging site that's packed with all kinds of great blogs. Whether it's a blog on new electronics, the internet, or playing golf you're sure to find one of interest here. It's also a great

space to start your own blog and get a little practice in.

- **BusyThumbs.com** – This UK based blog site is designed for camera phone images and text messages. It offers free moblogs, which is a mobile phone web log or online journal that you send via a text message. Registration is free. There are hundreds of blogs to choose from, and it ranks well in the search engines. You can upload from your phone to your blog in minutes, and is an excellent choice if you want to be able to
- **Trippert.com** – Create and share your blogs that are related to travel. This is a strong community with a strong following and a great place to start your travel blog no matter where you live or travel.
- **Ufem.com** – This is a blog site for women. There are multiple themes and plugins to choose from, and if your blog topic focuses around women this is a great place to start. It's a well visited site thanks to the great content and the additional resources relating to topics of interest to women.
- **WordCountJournal.com** – This is a new blogging format. On day one you'll write one word, on the second day two words, on the third day three words, and on it goes. By the end of the year, you will have written more than 65,000 words.

WordPress Powered

WordPress is one of the more popular blog publishing companies with a focus on usability, web standards, and aesthetics. There are a number of sites that are powered by WordPress.

- **Blogetery.com** – Is a little-known *WordPress platform* used by more than 70000 blogs. There are more than 140 free customizable themes, brilliant plugins, free sub-domains, anti-spam, and plenty more features. There's an opportunity to make money of your blog.
- **Edublogs.org** – WordPress powered blogs for educators is a resource that continues to grow and attract new visitors. Whether you are a teacher or a student you can quickly customize and design your own blog to include photos, podcasts, and videos. It's secure, safe, and easy to use.
- **WordPress.com** – This site offers you free, easy to customize blogs. Everything including, backups, spam blockers, security, upgrades, and setup is taken care for you. However, you have to use one of their themes and you cannot use plugins. There are plenty of widgets you can add, and tags are easy to add. You are not allowed to sell anything unless you are an artist or author.
- **WordPress.org** - This site requires more technical skills. It also has to be installed onto a server and upgraded by you anytime there are upgrades. You can sell things, post paid ads, and include a shopping cart. The software is free but hosting might cost you a few dollars a month.

- **Blog** – Free blog hosting and best of all unlimited bandwidth with even their free package.
- **Blogger.com** – This is a great site to get a taste of blogging from Google. Easy to use with plenty of tools to help you share your pictures, posts, and videos. You can make your blog look fantastic on a mobile device, and you can even view before going live.

- **BlogSpirit.com** – This is a European based blog site with a 30 day free trial and it offers a large amount of storage. BlogSpirit is a complete suite of blog products and services. In just minutes you can make a professional blog.
- **Blogster.com** – Free image hosting with your free blogs. Blogster is a blogging community that features specific interest blogs, with a large community of users and visitors.
- **Bloki.com** – Here you can build a blog site and open it up for partnership if you want. Bloki offers user friendly features and enough basic tools to help you get your blog up and running. It also features the ability to create links between your pages, and best of all it's free.
- **Bravenet.com** – Free blog and website hosting, build your blog using the easy web tools provided. It's never been easier to put together your own blog and reap the benefits of the volume of traffic that stops by the site to visit.
- **Xanga.com** – This is a blogging community where you can start your very own blog for free, share videos, and photos, and make new friends. It ranks well within Google search engine and offers you high traffic volume.
- **Zoomshare.com** – Zoomshare reaches a large audience made up of small business owners and individuals. With more than 1 million users it is continually growing and members have a wide range of interests. You can build and promote your website and Zoomshare. You can also create and grow your blog.
- **Windows Live Spaces** – This was once one of the most popular free blogging sites through your MSN account. It was then moved over to Live Space and when Live Spaces decided to stop services it was made easy for you to move your blog to WordPress. As of March 2011 Windows Live Spaces had been closed down, but deserved mentioning because so many people used it.

10 Essential Blogger Plugins and Blogger Widgets

When it comes to blogger plugins and widgets there's no question there are hundreds, but we've picked our top 10 essentials for some serious blogging. Let's have a look and find out what each has to offer.

1. Author Info Widget

Similar to WordPress author card info, which is displayed at the end of the post, Author Info Widget, will display the author biography at the end of each post for Blogger users. Author Info Widget shows you're about me text, gravatar, social network, mail address, and contact links of your post author.

2. Google Buzz Share Count Button

These days Google Buzz is doing a lot of buzzing, and it can be seen in Mashable. You can opt for the same on your Blogspot/Blogger blogs. Add Google Buzz Share Count Button to your blog, which will count and allow you to buzz your blog.

3. Subscribe Widget

This is a powerful free WordPress plugin. Every blog needs to have a social profile to get the users stay updated

with the blog updates. Most of the template comes with a subscribe widget on the sidebar and some don't. If your template doesn't have a subscribe widget, you can make use of this.

4. Recent Post With Thumbnails

One of the popular blogger widgets, created by Aneesh. Easy to customize, easy to integrate on your blogs, and the script is easy to install. The image thumbnails displayed for each related post are generated from the thumbnail associated with the relevant post page.

5. Featured Content Slider

This elegant featured content slider from Bloggermint, is a must have plugin, which will smoothly show an unlimited number of posts. It is easy to integrate into blogger and compatible with all major browsers.

6. MintShare

A Pure CSS3 and HTML based social share widget in five different variant from our Bloggermint labs. Mint Share is one of the few CSS and HTML based widget, and without any JavaScript the buttons are really fast-loading and small in size.

7. Accordion

This is a unique blogger widget from Abu Farhan. This will show or hide your widget on your sidebar. A first of its kind for blogger makes it easier for the visitor to read and not show all long posts. The script will show only the first post, then hide the rest.

8. Recent Post Sliding With Thumbnail and Simple Spy

This is another widget from Bloggertricks.com. Many would have seen simple spy in some design where the recent post fades in. This widget makes that possible with blogger blogs.

9. Random Rotating Banner

One of the best money making widgets for your blog is this easy to customize random rotating banner. You can even customize the number of ads to be rotated. You do have to do a couple of small template modification for the banner to work.

10. Twitter Follow Us Badge

Yet another blogger gadget that's worth using. With one click, you're able to add the floating Twitter follow us badge on your blog.

There are many more useful plugins and widgets available online but this is definitely a great place to start.

Best WordPress Widgets 2011

WordPress is like a gift from the search engine Gods. It is by far the most common blogging platform used. WordPress gives you an amazing opportunity to build a blog that ranks exceptionally well within the search engines, so if you haven't yet setup your WordPress blog, now's the right time to do that.

There are millions of WordPress blogs out there but only a handful get decent traffic. That's because few bloggers understand anything about search engine optimization or traffic generation, both key to bringing visitors to your blog. If you are using your blog to generate some form of income, you can only be successful if you are able to bring targeted traffic to the site.

Adding WordPress widgets is the easiest way to include some interactive areas to your blog. Widgets allow you to customize your blog as much or as little as you like. A quick Google search, and you'll quickly understand why you need a helping hand determining the best widgets to use in WordPress, which is exactly what we plan to do. Why not give your blog a little blogger power?

Don't confuse WordPress widgets and WordPress plugins though. WordPress widgets and plugins are a bit different. Plugins are functions that do something to your blog. They may never be seen by your blog visitors only serving a back-end purpose. However, a widget is generally the representation of a plugin in the form of an object that can be positioned anywhere on your website via the widgets interface in the appearance menu.

Widgets are always plugins, but plugins are not always widgets. A widget usually is an easy way of using a plugin. I hope this short explanation clears things up, for those who have just started using WordPress. You generally install WordPress plugins and then activate them. They usually help improve your blog's functionality and the public never knows they are there. On the other hand, you can share widgets with your visitors, in the sidebar or the footer.

It's a good idea to limit the number of widgets and plugins you incorporate in your blog. While there are thousands to choose from the reality is that too many can be overwhelming. Take time to decide what's most important to you and then include widgets and plugins to support that.

There are a handful of mandatory plugins that you must install, then there are also paid plugins that can be of great value. We've accumulated a list of those widgets and plugins we think deserve looking at.

1. All In One SEO Pack

You need to have this plug in! The *All In One SEO Pack* really is the ultimate in plugins. Features include:

- Automatically optimizes your titles for search engines.
- Provides SEO Integration for WP e-Commerce sites.
- Fine-tune Page Navigational Links.
- Advanced Canonical URLs.
- Built-in API, which allows other plugins/themes to access and extend functionality.
- Supports Custom Post Types Nonce Security.
- Avoids duplicate content typically found on WordPress blogs.
- Supports CMS-style WordPress installations.
- Automatically Generates META tags.
- Works right out-of-the-box. All you need to do is install. Great for beginners.
- For advanced users, everything can be fine-tuned.
- Backward-Compatibility with many other plugins, like Ultimate Tag Warrior or Auto Meta.

It's also one of the most famous WordPress plugins and best of all - it's free!

2. Google XML Sitemaps

The Google XML sitemap is pretty neat. In under a minute can build your website an xml sitemap, which will help search engines like Google, Yahoo, Ask, or Bing to better index your blog. This sitemap makes it easier for the crawlers to see the complete structure of your site and retrieve it more efficiently. It will also ping the search

engines each time you post a new content. It's a must have plugin

3. WP Super Cache

This plugin is high up on my list for one reason, because it makes your site load much faster! What it does is store a static html version of your site making it use way less CPU so it will load much faster for the site visitor. It can be an enormous help to your overall site's success. (people hate waiting for pages to load) 99% of all site visitors will be served by static html files. Static files are served to:

- Users who are not logged in.
- Users who have not left a comment on your blog.
- Or users who have not viewed a password protected post.

4. My Most Popular Posts.

This widget is fantastic and so useful for you and your visitors. It helps you and your visitors navigate to the most viewed posts.

5. SEO Smart Links

SEO Smart Links is not only cool – it works great and is a highly effective SEO WordPress plugin. It will help you with on-page SEO like most WP SEO plugins, automatically linking keywords to other pages on your site. All of this works to build a stronger page rank throughout your entire site. You can enter a custom set of keywords and URL's.

6. My Random Posts

Random posts will display all of your posts randomly in my sidebar. Your visitors just might find a post they find interesting without a visit to the sitemap page.

7. SEO Friendly Images

Images are a well kept secret. Most bloggers are unaware that images can be a huge source of traffic. This cool plugin helps you optimize your images so they rank well in the Google Image search.

8. My Recent Post Widgets.

By default it is installed with WordPress. It displays what you have written recently, so your visitors can quickly see the most updated posts.

9. Sexy Bookmarks

Here is another very useful plugin. Before each post it will display a bookmarking tab which lets readers share your content on social network/bookmarking sites like Facebook, Twitter, StumbleUpon, and Digg.

10. Fast Secure Contact Form

This is a very useful plugin that lets you create contact forms anywhere on your blog. It is an easy way to collect a large number of contacts.

11. My Categories

This built in widget allows you to show as many categories as you want. It also displays the most popular category.

12. Category RSS

The RSS widget lets you provide links that allow your visitors to subscribe to your blog posts for any category they find interesting.

13. LJ Longtail SEO

While it's weird name might have you overlook this plug in it's actually very useful because it tracks all incoming visitors and the keywords they used to find your blog. It then takes that information collected and places a link in your sidebar using the keyword as anchor text linking to the post or page the visitor came to.

14. Archives

This is another built-in widget that displays archives to your visitors showing what you've posted to your blog so far.

15. Search widget.

Some themes have the search box while others don't. If your theme doesn't have the search you can activate this widget box. It's very helpful for visitors who want to find a specific post.

16. WP DB Backup

The WP DB Backup is more than capable of running your site's backups, which are essential in case of a server crash that leaves you with your posts all gone.

17. CommentLuv

This plugin encourages visitors to leave comments by offering links to their last posts. Once installed, when a visitor posts a comment, they will get a link back to their last blog post. It's simple to install and use, yet so very powerful.

As a member of The ComLuv Network, when you can register your site URL you receive 10x the luv when you comment on enabled blogs. If you begin a blog here, you can even add your twitter and digg accounts to your returned posts or add up to 5 more blogs.

18. SEO Pressor

SEO Pressor is one of those famous SEO plugins, used by thousands. It works by telling you exactly how to optimize your posts for search engine domination. Now that's handy! SEO Pressor will score you out of 100 for your on-page optimization for the keyword you input, and it will also provide you with a check list of things to "optimize".

19. Pingback Optimizer

This great little plugin really helps, especially if you are an article marketer. It collects all of your blog's pingbacks, then it uses them to create RSS feeds, and submits them to the top RSS aggregators. Pingbacks are backlinks, so when other blogs link to yours, you want them indexed, and it does a great job of this and it leads to increases traffic.

20. WP Silo SEO

This great little plug in is for SEO and internet marketers who understand LSI. You will be able to rank for all kinds of search terms with no effort on your part.

There you have it – a list of what we consider mandatory WordPress plugins and widgets that you shouldn't be without if you want to make the most out of your WordPress blog. Just because everyone you know is running a blog, doesn't mean it's successfully. Running a blog is hard work and plugins and widgets just make it that much easier.

50 Best WordPress Plugins and Widgets for Power Blogging

We've just had a look at what we consider to be 20 mandatory WordPress plugins and widgets, but there are plenty more. Since WordPress is one of the hottest blogging platforms, we thought you could use a little more help. You'll find 50 of the best WordPress plugins and widgets below broken down by category. Don't be afraid to give them a try. Power blogging just got a little easier.

Manage WordPress Comments

- **Subscribe To Comments** – This robust plugin enables commenters to sign up for e-mail notification of subsequent comment entries.
- **WP AJAX Edit Comments** – Users are able to edit, move, or blacklist their own comments on a post online for a limited time using AJAX and Admin can edit all comments. You can undo functionality for most of the editing options, and you can choose different icon sets to use on your blog.
- **Close Old Posts** – Allows you to close comments on old posts without the need for a DB query.
- **WP Grins** – Allows you to put clickable smilies on your post and comments forms.
- **Live Comment Preview** – This is the easiest way to see what you're your comment will look like on the site as you type it.
- **Show Top Commentators** – Encourages more posts by visitors, by displaying their names and number of comments they have made recently to your sidebar.
- **MyAvatars** – Shows MyBlogLogs avatars in your comments
- **Comment Relish** – This slick little tool will send a thank you e-mail to your first time commentators.
- **Favatars** – Displays the favicon linked with the commenters website.
- **Dofollow** – Allows you to remove the nofollow attribute from your comments.
- **OpenID Comments for WordPress** – Users are able to leave comments using their OpenID.
- **Extended Comment Options** – You can switch comments or pings on/ off for batches of existing posts.
- **Get Recent Comments** – Displays excerpts of the most recent comments and/or trackbacks that have been posted to the articles in your blog.

Expert WordPress SEO

You will significantly increase the traffic to your WordPress blog by using SEO tools. Titles and content should be optimized for keywords. Here are some of the best WordPress tools.

- **Google XML Sitemaps Generator** – A sitemap is created for all articles on your WordPress blog, which aids Google and other search engines to quickly index all content you write.
- **Permalink Redirect** – If the requested URI is different from entry's permalink it replies with a 301 permanent redirect. It is used to ensure that there is only one URL associated with each blog entry.
- **All in One SEO Pack** – Your WordPress blog will be optimized for the search engines

- **Head META Description** – Post excerpts are used to insert HTML META description tags.
- **Enforce www. Preference** – Helps preserve your permalinks by enforcing your no-www or yes-www preference and will strip off index.php from the ends of URIs.
- **Broken Link Checker** – Monitors and notifies you for broken links on your blog.
- **Quick META Keywords** – META Keywords tags are automatically added to every post based on the category the article is filed under.

Easy WordPress Navigation

Easy navigation is important to your blog and sidebars are an integral part of every WordPress blog. These widgets and plugins can help you make the most of your blog theme.

- **Related Entries** – Provides a list of the associated entries based on active and/or passive keyword(s) that match. Will increase your page views because it targets related content.
- **Yet Another Related Posts Plugin (YARPP)** – Gives you a list of posts and/or pages related to the current entry.
- **WP-PageNavi** – Adds an advanced page navigation to WordPress, which is helpful for navigation on index and category pages.
- **Evermore** – When viewed on multiple post pages it abbreviates all posts. Supportive when creating WordPress expandable posts summaries.
- **Random Redirect** – You can create a link to a random post on your blog. Allows readers to browse in a manner similar to StumbleUpon.
- **WP-Cumulus** – Displays your tags and/or categories in 3D by placing them on a rotating sphere
- **Lightbox JS Plugin** – Allows you to overlay images on your current page into neat Javascript-powered overlay popups.
- **Homepage Excerpts** – Gives flexibility to use both full posts and excerpts on the homepage.
- **WordPress Mobile Edition** – A powerful interface intended for viewing on mobile devices.
- **Popularity Contest** – Keeps count of your posts, archive views, categories, trackbacks, comments, etc. and uses this information to determine most popular posts.
- **Clean Archives** – Displays your archive listings in a clean and organized manner. It lists the month/day/year of published articles, the title of each blog, and the number of comments made on each blog.
- **Custom Query String** – Sets the number of posts for each page on your blog like archives, categories, or search results pages.
- **KB Advanced RSS Widget** – This WordPress widget offers you total control over how RSS feeds are parsed for your sidebar.
- **Permalinks Migration Plugin** – Safely change your permalink structure without breaking the old links to your website or affecting your search engine rankings.

Stop WordPress Spam

While spam may be a fact of life if you have a blog, WordPress tools have gone the extra mile in an attempt to reduce spam and they've done a good job. Let's have a look at some of the most popular.

- **Akismet** – Intelligent blocking of spam comments by checking your comments against the Akismet web service to determine if they are/are not spam.
- **Bad Behavior** – This is a set of PHP scripts that stop spambots from being able to access your blog. It does this by analyzing the HTTP request and then doing a comparison of the spambots.
- **WP-Contact Form with Spam Protection** – A contact form is created on your blog, which allows readers to easily contact you.
- **Defensio** – A spam filtering web service to block comment spam.
- **Digital Fingerprint** – Useful for detecting content theft.

WordPress Twitter Plugins

- **TweetSuite** – Integrate Twitter with your blog with server-side TweetBacks, ReTweet-This buttons, digg-like Tweet-This Button, automatic tweeting of new posts etc.
- **WP Twitip ID** –Add your twitter username to the comment form

Interactive WordPress Posts

- **Share This** – Allows visitors to add your post to a variety of social bookmarking sites, or send friends a link by e-mail.
- **Sociable** – Automatically adds links to your favorite social bookmarking sites on your posts, pages and in your RSS feed.
- **WP-Email** – Lets visitors recommend and send your blog post to a friend.
- **WP-PostRatings** – Adds the AJAX rating system to your blog's posts.
- **Viper's Video QuickTags** – Easy posting of videos from various websites such as YouTube, DailyMotion, Vimeo etc.

WordPress Admin Management Tools

- **PodPress** – Adds all kinds of features intended to make WordPress the ideal platform for hosting a podcast.
- **TinyMCE Advanced** –16 plugins are added to TinyMCE, which is WordPress' wysiwyg editor, and it adds more than 40 new buttons to the toolbar, which is now two rows plus one hidden row.
- **Exec-PHP** – Permits php tags inside the content of your posts/pages to be executed just as usual PHP files.
- **Photo Dropper** – Now you can easily add free photos to your blog posts without leaving WordPress.
- **WordPress.com Stats** – Tracks views, post views, clicks, and referrers. A WordPress API key is required.
- **Admin Drop Down Menu** – Eliminates double clicking on Admin screens by letting you see the second level menu by mouse hovering over a main menu.

- **FeedBurner** – Make sure all your RSS feed subscribers get counted along with the ones signed up via FeedBurner.
- **FeedStats** – Gives you statistical data on your feeds.
- **Feedvertizer** – Add text links to the end of your feed posts.
- **Slash Comments** – Adds info to your feed about how many comments are on the post.
- **Subscribe-Remind** – Adds a little reminder to subscribe to your feed at the end of each post.
